Quality Managers Training

This year, EN*plus*[®] will organise Quality Managers Training courses in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Poland, Serbia and Slovenia. The elearning training is available in English, Ukrainian, French and Turkish as an option for quality managers of certified companies in countries different from the aforementioned. Market Surveillance Project

The Market Surveillance Project is an initiative aiming at analysing $\mathsf{EN} plus^{\mathbb{R}}$ certified bags of pellets randomly taken from the market in order to assure compliance with the scheme's standards. The project is part of $\mathsf{EN} plus^{\mathbb{R}}$ procedures for constant quality control and is open to anyone who wants
